**READ CAREFULLY**: Vessel Upgrade Grants of up to \$17,500\* for owners of set net operations and up to \$35,000\* for drift vessel owners are offered to year-round residents of BBEDC CDQ or watershed communities with a history of active participation in Bristol Bay's commercial salmon fishery, and who hold an Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission Bristol Bay salmon fishing permit or have a contractual agreement to fish with a Bristol Bay salmon permit holder who is also a year-round watershed resident. Applicants can do all or part of the work themselves, or contract all or part of the work to another party. NO PAYMENT WILL BE MADE WITHOUT: (1) a signed Vessel Upgrade Contract from BBEDC; (2) proof that the work described in the applicant's work plan is complete; (3) a signed acceptance agreement from the applicant verifying that the work is complete and satisfactory. Complete Vessel Upgrade Grant Policies are available at BBEDC Offices

Failure to maintain residency as defined by BBEDC <u>and</u> remain an active participant in the Bristol Bay salmon fishery for the subsequent three (3) consecutive years using the same vessel or set net equipment contracted through this grant program, except that it may be the subsequent two (2) consecutive years if the vessel or set net equipment is transferred to a watershed resident to be actively used in the commercial fishery will result in legal action to force repayment of funds, with possible tax consequences and penalties.

\*Past recipients of lesser Vessel Upgrade Grants are eligible for the balance of up to \$17,500 or \$35,000. Additionally, past recipients who have not received a Vessel Upgrade Grant in the previous three years can apply for a new full grant award\*

Applications accepted until April 5, 2024. Early submissions are encouraged.

Applicants in default in any BBEDC programs are no longer eligible to participate in additional BBEDC programs or services until fully compliant.
