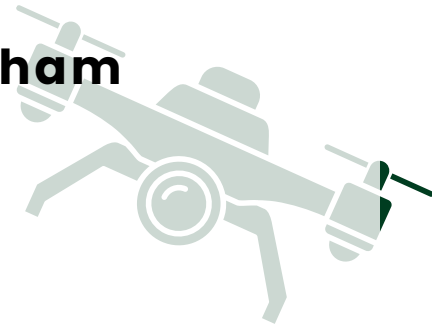


# Seasonal Fisheries Technician / Drone Assistant

## Qualifications:

- **BBEDC CDQ community resident**
- **Must be 18 or older**
- **Valid Alaska Driver's License preferred**
- **Comfortable living and working in a remote field camp (cabin/bunkhouse in bear country)**
- **Able to work flexible hours based on weather and fish run timing**
- **Interest in fisheries management, technology, or aviation**
- **Experience with small boats preferred**
- **Basic computer skills preferred**

## Duties:

- **Assist with the setup and daily operation of drone equipment and starlink satellite systems at a remote site on the Wood River**
- **Serve as a visual observer during drone flights to ensure air space safety and regulatory compliance**
- **Shift duration could be from 6 to 10 hours a day. (work intensity varies - estimated 4 - 5 hours)**
- **Work hours will be 7 days a week when the fish are running with overtime determined daily**
- **Assist with organizing image data and maintaining field logs**
- **Travel by skiff between the field sites and the UW Fisheries Research Institute (FRI) camp in Aleknagik**
- **Other duties as assigned**
